The Congress welcomes studies related to all aspects of animal biodiversity (terrestrial,

subterranean, freshwater, and marine) within the geographical region that includes the Balkan

and Italian peninsulas, Anatolia, as well as the Near East and the Mediterranean coasts of

north-eastern Africa. The deadline for submission of abstracts is 30 April 2025 (max. 500

words). Time allocated for oral presentations will be 15 minutes, followed by 5 minutes

discussion. Please, check the website (https://iczegar16.hzoos.gr/) for instructions on the

preparation and submission of your abstract. The selection of oral presentation will be done

by the Scientific Committee.
